RULES AND REGULATIONS

Eligibility:

All national, international, amateur and professional bowlers are welcome to participate. To qualify for the senior division, you must be 50 years old by the first of January the year of the competition. Evidence may be required.

Technical Meeting:

The technical meeting will be held before the Tournament begins. The date, time and place will be determined and informed in advance. At this meeting the Tournament Manager and the Technical Team will be covering the rules of the tournament. This will be the time to clear up your doubts.

Tournament Management:

The Technical Committee will be in charge of running the Tournament. This Committee is composed by:

- a) The Tournament Director
- b) The Technical Director
- c) The Statistic Director

Competition:

There will be the following divisions: male and female, and two categories: regulars and seniors. Seniors and regulars' male teams will consist of 4 bowlers (they can be mixed) and seniors and regulars' female teams consist of two females. Those women who choose to play in the men's category will not be eligible for awards in the female's category for any event.

Handicap:

The handicap for this event will be **90% of the difference from the base average of 215 for men and 90% of 200 for women.** The average will be established as follows: the highest average of leagues or tournaments in which it has participated from January 1 to December 31 of the year prior to the celebration of the Tournament, or with the average established in TIBPR 2024 and 2025, whichever is greater. Those participants who have not played in leagues or tournaments in the year prior to the celebration of the Tournament will play "scratch". The maximum handicap will be 40 pins per game. The final averages will be published 48-72 hours before the start of the competition in the assigned bowling alley and on the official TIBPR website. If there are complaints, they must be informed with evidence and in writing to tibpr_info@yahoo.com. Any erroneous average, offered by the player, will be corrected, if it is discovered before the start of the Tournament. If discovered after the Tournament has begun, you will be awarded a "0" handicap retroactively if you have completed any event.

Errors in scoring:

Score or calculation errors will be corrected as soon as they are discovered by authorized personnel. Questionable errors will be considered by the Technical Committee. The time limit to protest score or calculation errors will be one hour before of the next event. This protest shall be in writing and will have no cost.

Severance Clauses:

Any situation that arises, not covered in these Regulations, will be resolved by the Technical Committee and its decision will be final and firm. For rules not covered in these regulations, the USBC rules will be used as guides.

Game format:

All senior men and women playing in the adult division will be eligible for the senior All Events only, **but only if it's notified to the Statistics Director the first day before practices begins.**

All games will be played on the same assigned lanes for each tournament event.

Adult and senior male Division:

Special Event and Finals

These events will be held on Saturday, **starting at 10:30am**. They will consists of a match play style straight from one game to total pins with handicap. Positions 4-6 will play one game, and the winner will face position #3. The winner of that game will face position #2 and that winner will face position #1.

The classification for this event consists of:

- a) **The top 6 positions in the regular male category**

- b) The top 6 positions in the regular women's category
- c) The top 6 positions in the senior male category
- d) The top 6 positions in the senior women's category

The stepladder finals will be played "match play" one game, total pins with handicap

All Events champions in each category will enter directly to the stepladder, but they must play the 3 games to determine their position.

Team Line-ups:

The team's line-up must be established on the inscription form. If not informed, the line-up will be set as it appears on the inscription form.

For the Doubles Event, team line-ups must be informed 15 minutes after the Team Events are finished, otherwise the Technical Committee will determine the line-up.

Ties breaking procedures:

If there is a tie for an award in any of the events, the award will be shared.

Playing uniforms:

Male Division – it will consist of a sports shirt with sleeves, long pants, bermudas or jeans.

Female Division – it will consist of a sports shirt with sleeves, pants, bermudas, skirts, jeans or leggings.

The outfits must comply with the dress code of the bowling center.

Tardy or Absent Players:

Absent player will receive 0 score. Tardy players will have 0 score for each frame missed and will start the game in the frame being played, once he is ready.

Substitutions:

In case a participant cannot continue playing, a substitute, who has 10 pins more or less of the average of the replacement, can be used, but will not be eligible for the All Events.

“Side Action”:

Any concept of "side action" – including, but not limited to, poker, "high game pots" or some other form of additional betting, **must be previously authorized by the Organizing Committee**. The Organizing Committee will carry out "strike jackpot" or "strike ball", unlimited brackets, senior and adult, with and without handicap. Failure to comply with this rule may result in disqualification or expulsion from the event without refund.

Temporarily Interrupted game: .

Tournament officials will authorize that a game is to be completed in another pair of lanes if an equipment failure delays the normal progress of the competition.

Re-racks:

A maximum of 2 re-racks per player will be allowed per series.

Discipline:

The Discipline Committee will consist of the Tournament Director and the Technical Team. The Tournament Director will receive all filed complaints. After summoning all parts involved, the Technical Committee will evaluate the claim and will make a final decision. **Any complaint must be submitted in writing no more than one hour after the event finalized and will have a cost \$50.00**, which will be refunded if the Technical Committee, resolves the complaint in favor of the plaintiff. Any player or companion must maintain the code of sportsmanship and

discipline both inside and outside the premises of the bowling center. This includes the places where official activities of the tournament are being held. Any misbehavior will lead to immediate expulsion from the tournament without the right to a refund. Both the Tournament Organizing Committee and the bowling center reserves the right of admission.

Competition Area:

Only authorized personnel may be in the Player's Area.

Emergency rule:

Any situation not covered in these regulations shall be resolved by the Technical Committee and its decision will be final.

In case of technical disagreements concerning a translation:

Technical disagreements due to any inconsistency with the translation of these rules, a final decision will be based on the intention of the regulation, as is meant on the native language, which is Spanish.




